Q: Was there an incumbent prior and is the goods the same?

A: **Yes.**

Q: What was their contact number and amount used to execute the contract?

A: **Refer to IFB: verify by SFA usage.**

Q: What is your budget for this project?

A: **Each SFA will have its own budget for commodity products.**

Q: Will the contract be awarded to one or several contractors?

A: **Contract may be awarded to several manufacturers.**

Q: Is a bond required?

A: **No.**



Q: Can you tell me if Fayette County commodity beef bid is to be submitted to Fayette County as a direct ship bid? Or will this bid, once awarded, be issued to the distributor that you all will be using?
