We will follow GHSA football rules with the exceptions listed below.

- 10-minute running clock quarters. 3 minutes and 1 minute between quarters.
- There will be 1 untimed down at the end of each quarter. (No Timeouts)
- We will play **4 quarters**. 2 fulltime Defense and 2 full time offense
- Each team will be on offense or defense for the entire quarter. Ex: Team A is offense
 in Q1, Team B is on defense. At the start of Q2, Team A is on defense and Team B
 will take over on offense.
- Each offensive series will begin on the 40-yard line going in.
- There will be no kicking game, teams will just go for it on 4th down, if successful, the
 drive continues, if unsuccessful, the ball returns back to the 40-yard line and the
 team continues on offense.
- If the offense turns the ball over, by fumble or interception, the offensive team will retain possession back at the 40-yard line.
- If a team scores a touchdown, there will be no extra point attempt, and the offensive team will restart on offense back at the 40-yard line.

- Each team is allowed one Coach on the field during the game.
- Teams reserve the right to work on specific game situations (ie 2 minute drill, goal line off/def) if agreed upon by both coaches. Remember, this gives teams an opportunity to practice
