IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- → Seniors: Your School Counselor will meet individually with you between late August-November to discuss the path to graduation, post-secondary plans, and how to use Naviance to send required application materials to colleges/universities. If a recommendation letter is needed for a college application and/or scholarship, students are required to complete the Brag Sheet located on Schoology and share it with his/her counselor. As a courtesy, students should ask teachers and counselors for recommendation letters at least 3 weeks prior to the application deadline.
- → Fayette County Probe Fair: The Probe Fair is a post secondary tour, offered every fall, which showcases an array of educational options, from renowned research universities to hands-on vocational and technical schools, ensuring Georgia students from every background can discover academic paths that suit their interests and aspirations.
