

Statement of Objection to the Use of Social Security Number For Student Identification

Georgia law (20-2-0150) requires public school authorities to request from parents and guardians the Social Security number for students being enrolled in school. This law allows parents or guardians who object to this requirement to sign a statement of objection which will act as a waiver. No student will be denied enrollment in a public school for declining to provide a Social Security number or for declining to apply for such a number.

The Social Security number will be used for identification purposes and will be incorporated into official school records pertaining to that student. The confidentiality of the number will be kept in accordance with applicable state and federal law.

Statement of Objection

I do not wish to provide Fayette County Public Schools with the Social Security number of my child/children. I understand that by declining to provide my child's SSN, they may not be eligible for certain programs or scholarships that require it, such as the Georgia Hope Scholarship.
